Memorandum that we Socanaca Sachem of Pekiwon Muckins Amiscowd Quawhach and Monatue
 Okanakasuke sachander wauwona sonnon Coscome And Asquamay for and in Consideration of the
 sume of Thousd. pounds & ten shillings that we haue Residu'd in good reuechable yeare of
 and at the hands of Robert Colles William Carpenter Richard Chasmore all of Yantucke And
 William Carpenter of Rehoboth. Dode by these presents Covenant yromis And grant and by these pres-
 ents his Dode Covenant yromis and grant to make us a sufficient fence about all our Cōnes feildes that
 now or any other tyme amouest us haue at present or ever here after shall haue in or about
 the lands lying with in the boundes of yantucke the which fence shall bee sufficient to keepe out any
 Ruther Cattell of Cowe kinde or hogs beast sheepe or goats at our owne yspesell Costes and Chargeys
 And all so we bind our selues our heires and assigns foyrmly by these presents to the above said Robert
 Colles William Carpenter and Richard Chasmore of yantucke and William Carpenter of Rehoboth their
 heires and assigns to keepe Royallise and maintain sufficient fence to secure our Cōnes or any-
 thing else we haue or herafter we haue or assigns maye or shall haue from the hunting or
 Damislyng by any such beast or Cattell as is aboue Specified in so much that if any hurt or damage
 to Cōne or faull out unto us our heires or assigns with in any of the boundes as aboue said either upon
 our Cōne or any other thing we haue or herafter shall haue done by any such beastes or Cattell
 which is aboue mentioned done with out any Complaint tribell or shield of law to bēare the ney
 And Damages our selfes our heires & assigns or any other tyme that by our leade or yspacement
 shall Cōne or lie by us or amouest us with in any of the boundes aboue said and this Covenant shall
 stand fydme and Remaine sted against us our heires & assigns dydu: so long as we do place that
 we haue at present haue or herafter shall breake up or make upon any of our lands with in the
 boundes aboue specified: In witness whereof we do herre unto sett our handes dydu: the day & year above written
 signed and delivered

the names of the Indians that haue sett thire handes to the grant & deed with these
 Socanaca - Muckins - Canimone -
 Okanakasuke - Amiscowd - Coscomd
 Keywahacke - Asquamay - Socananc
 Kenawawost - And Monatue -

These presonts is a true Coppy of the grant and deed that was made
 by the Indians aboue said to the parties aboue said the which grant and
 deed is in the hand and Custodie of me William Carpenter of Rehoboth
 And this presonts I make and assign over unto William Carpenter of yantucke
 for his assurance and to satisfie all men whome it may concern and
 is made verbatim with the grants Deed in witness whereof I do
 sett my hand herre unto.
