The following book is a supplemental work to the 1898 Carpenter Memorial

This independent work adds descendants of brothers Ebenezer and Amos Carpenter. It also adds some information that is not in the 1898 Carpenter Memorial on the Carpenter ancestry.

Ebenezer Carpenter is Number 465 in the Carpenter Memorial on page 99. He is RIN 6512. A family is listed as Family 193. Moses Carpenter is Number 466 in the Carpenter Memorial on page 99. He is RIN 6513. A family is listed as Family 194.

On page 87 of the following book (digital page 44 of 123), the following is cited.

### **CHAPTER 8 The Tyringham Story: Ebenezer and Amos Seek Their Fortune**

Sometime between May 1777 and October 1778 Ebenezer and Amos left Coventry, their birthplace and the home of their father and grandfather-perhaps forever. On October 12, 1778 Ebenezer bought a farm from Stephen Taylor in Tyringham, Mass paying three hundred and forty pounds for the property. Eight months later he bought additional land from, of all people, William Hale. Amos bought property in Tyringham at about the same time.

The Carpenter Memorial by Amos B Carpenter (not to be confused with our Amos) had been a great help in tracing our ancestry. but when Ebenezer left Coventry Amos B Carpenter lost him. In fact his volume merely indicates that at some time he had moved to Lebanon, Connecticut and never credits him with more than one

child. Thus, from then on we were entirely on our own. For a time we could not be sure that the Ebenezer mentioned in the Memorial and my great great grandfather were one and the same. However, birth, marriage and death dates established his identity without question. It did mean, however, that from 1777 forward Amos B Carpenter was of no further aid in tracing our ancestry.
